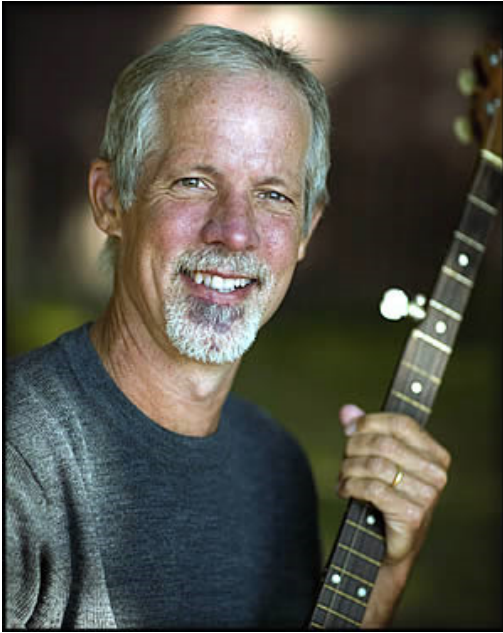


## Bill Gordh
