

Director of A3 Learning

All Saints Episcopal School seeks a leader to help launch the A3 Learning (Agile, Agency, and Authentic) program. This innovative position will allow an educational leader to collaborate and design this program with the All Saints leadership and will report directly to the Head of School. In addition, they will be responsible for showcasing and promoting the unique programs that utilize A3 principles, such as, the Learning Farm, Science Explorium, Learning Villages, Lower School Maker Oasis, Middle School STEM Zone, Upper School Fab Lab, Entrepreneurial E-Cafe and Retail Store, Copper Roof Media, Virtual Reality Labs, Broadcast/Radio Digi Studio, Outdoor Learning Center, and more.

This program is an innovative program that is the result of an Edward E. Ford grant. The three primary goals of the program are:

- 1) To create and sustain an Annual Workshop for teachers and students
- 2) To build relationships with national, regional and local conferences to include A3 programming and A3 certified leaders to present
- 3) To maintain an online platform to network A3 schools and educators together and share resources

The ideal candidate should:

- Possess a passion for agile frameworks, authentic learning, and student agency as demonstrated by innovative teaching experience.
- Have a bachelor's degree, with an advanced degree preferred.
- Have a preferred three years of teaching experience, ideally in an independent school environment.
- Demonstrate excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- Possess creative and innovative skills..
- Nurture enthusiasm for working in learning environments that Ignite Passions to Impact Our World.

Additional opportunities that exist for involvement in the All Saints community include leading an advisory, coaching, and sponsoring a club or field trip. Teachers at All Saints are expected to have a strong commitment to the students and the school community, working collaboratively with colleagues and supporting all aspects of school life.
