This position is full time and reports directly to the Head of Early Childhood.

- Work alongside the Kindergarten team to plan, supervise, and implement the program for the early childhood class in accordance with the policies, curriculum, and philosophy of the school to treat each child with dignity and respect.
- Develop and implement an enrichment curriculum along with the Kindergarten team and manage the “Centers Room” or enrichment space for all Kindergarten students.
- Provide support for each child’s academic needs and help develop social and emotional maturity.
- Attend all required meetings and public-relations events and participate on school committees and in extra-curricular activities as required.
- Uphold and support the mission of the Episcopal Church and school, meet all teacher expectations and duties as outlined in the Employee Manual.
- Collaborate with colleagues while maintaining a positive team attitude.

- Experience as a lead/homeroom teacher in early childhood education preferred
- Strength in literacy and phonics instruction
- Ability to differentiate curriculum for students with varying readiness

- Willingness to work in a collaborative, team environment
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills
