Candidates should have a bachelor's degree or higher in literature or a related field, excellent teaching skills, strong character, deep subject knowledge, and an ability to work collaboratively with the Middle School English Department. Writing instruction and literary analysis in a discussion-based classroom are emphasized. Our English classes use content to build inquiry and develop skills in critical thinking, writing, problem solving, research, and speaking. The ideal candidate should love working with middle schoolers, design learning experiences that help students examine literature through a critical lens and build exciting opportunities for exploration and other forms of student-centered learning.
