

St. Michael's is fully accredited by the Southwestern Association of Episcopal Schools, which is recognized by the National Association of Independent Schools and the State of Arizona. St. Michael's School is listed on the Register of Historic Places and is situated on a three-acre campus in east-central Tucson. A true marriage of the old and the new, the School encompasses 21 classrooms built around four traditional Spanish courtyards. In everything it does, the School emphasizes personal care for the whole child, helping and nurturing each student to grow and develop intellectually, socially, emotionally, physically, and spiritually.
